The Environment Group within AOK is concerned with looking at the current state of the environment in and around the village and then deciding how best to enhance what already exists.

and around the village. All litter collecting equipment and a friendly welcome are provided for both groups and WDC provides refreshments at the Saltings.

We have also been looking at ways of making a difference quickly; to get maximum effect from minimum effort and cost. Ideas considered so far are:

- Replacement/repair of benches in village.
- Painting of bollards and replacement of their cracked concrete base areas. A mosaic treatment of the bollard bases to link with the 'Roman' theme.
- Power washing of slabs and low wall all at the village centre shops.

We hope to work in partnership with the Council on these projects to achieve an improved environment for all who live in and visit Old Kilpatrick.

HORTICULTURE

It might be winter but the Horti subgroup have certainly not been dormant! We have lifted all the bedding plants from the beds, taken cuttings and put everything to overwinter in the greenhouse, and planted spring bulbs in the beds for early colour.

For this year, we aim to:

- Replant the existing beds
- Provide raised planters at each of the three village entrances
- Plant some fruit trees at locations to be agreed in the village – any suggestions welcomed!
- Take advantage of training sessions offered by the Council and Royal Horticultural Society (RHS)

Upcoming tasks are to scrub the greenhouse clean and complete a Lottery funding application that will provide us with funds for our activities.

HISTORY

The 'History, Heritage, and Archaeology' interest group have selected a project based on Cairndow's 'Our Houses: Their Stories'.

Our project will involve researching the history of a range of houses in Old Kilpatrick, from the very old to the more recent. It is expected that database searches will produce a timeline of occupancy, e.g. using Census information. Then, with permission, oral histories will be taken to gather the recent and not so recent memories of occupants, relating to their homes. The findings will be disseminated through posters, talks to local groups and a website. It is hoped that this will provide a fascinating and varied portrait of some Old Kilpatrick houses.
